For junk mail with your address ...



Register with the **Mailing Preference Service (MPS)** .

Send MPS your name and address and you will gradually receive less addressed junk mail. It takes up to four months to start completely and lasts five years.

You will still receive mail from companies that you have done business with in the past e.g. catalogue companies. Please contact them direct to remove your name from their lists.

All members of a household with the same surname are covered.

For junk mail with no address...

Register with **Royal Mail Door to Door Service**.

Much of your unaddressed junk mail is posted on a regional basis using services like Royal Mail Door to Door. By registering your name and full address you will stop receiving some unaddressed junk mail. This can take up to six weeks to start.
